

Invitation to the Lesbos Delegation of CPT

Juni 9 to 15, 2025

The island of Lesvos has always been a hub of cultures. Even today, you can experience a colourful diversity of languages, art and ways of life on the island. Unfortunately, the European border regime is experimenting with various methods of border militarisation to keep migrants away from the EU by means of confinement, scare tactics and illegal pushbacks.

- In our delegation we will place the situation of migrants on Lesvos in a broader geographical, historical and political context.
- We meet with local activists, experts, organisations and individuals who are committed to solidarity with migrants. We will learn about a wide range of activities that are actively challenging the structures of injustice on the island and in Europe.
- We will engage with Aegean Migrant Solidarity, a team of passionate activists from Community Peacemaker Teams, who monitor trials of criminalised migrants, organize protests and actions against the illegal and deadly practice of pushbacks and who think deeply about issues of equality and justice in the face of the transformation of the island into an open-air prison.

We invite you to join us in learning about the troubling, unjust politics at the heart of Europe. Join us in meeting and gaining inspiration from activists on the island. Another world without violence is possible!
